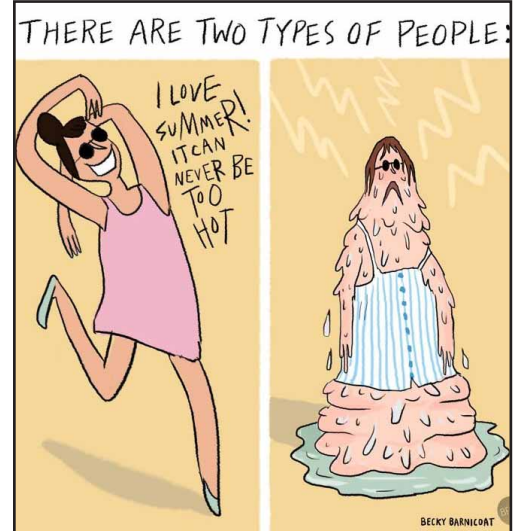

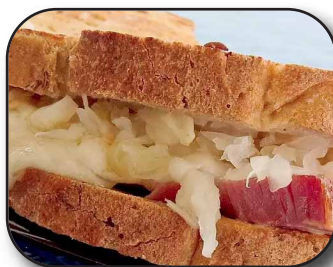


Campfire Reubens

Prep: 15 mins Cook: 30 mins
Total: 45 mins Servings: 4

Ingredients

- 8 slices pumpernickel bread
- 1 cup Thousand Island dressing
- $\frac{3}{4}$ pound deli sliced corned beef
- $\frac{1}{2}$ pound sliced Swiss cheese
- 1 cup sauerkraut



Directions

Preheat a grill for low heat.

Cut 4 large squares of aluminum foil. Place 2 slices of bread side-by-side on each piece of foil.

Spread the bread slices with Thousand Island dressing. Evenly divide the corned beef, Swiss cheese, and sauerkraut among the bread.

Top with a second slice of bread to make a sandwich. Wrap the foil snugly around the sandwich to make a sealed packet.

Place the packets on the preheated grill. Cook, turning every 10 minutes, until the bread is lightly toasted and cheese melted, about 30 minutes.

How do you keep a Reuben sandwich from getting soggy?

For the perfect crunch on any toasted sandwich, spread the outside of the bread with mayonnaise instead of butter, and melt some butter in your pan before toasting the sandwich. When making a toasted sandwich, use cheese as a barrier between the bread and the sandwich fillings to keep the bread from getting soggy.

What is a Rachel vs a Reuben? A Reuben is made with corned beef and a Rachel is made with Turkey and some put coleslaw on the sandwich.

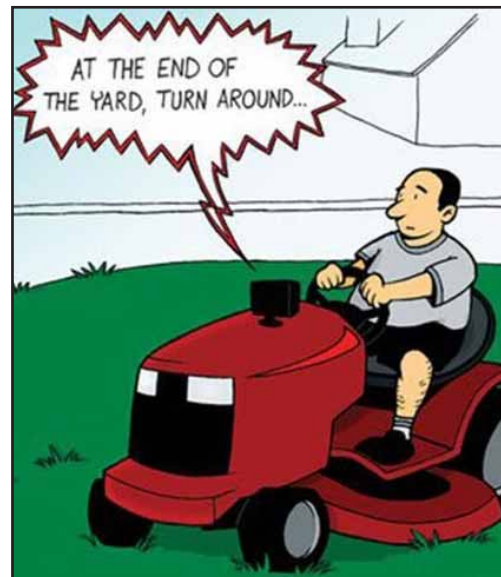
